(2) Use of Motorized Recreational Vehicles

The use of motorized recreational-type vehicles, registered with the Motor Vehicle department or not, shall be prohibited on public school property except as a means of normal transportation in the regular school driveways and parking lots.

For the purposes of clarification, motorized recreational-type vehicles are defined as, but not limited to, ski-mobiles, go-carts, mopeds, scooters, all-terrain vehicles, dirt-track and regular motorcycles.
