2. Administrative Operations

B. Administrative Discretion in Absence of Board of Education Policy

Where the Board of Education has provided no guidelines for administrative action, the Superintendent shall have the authority to act. It shall be the duty of the Superintendent to inform the Board of Education promptly of such action and of the need for possible additional policies, or revision of existing policies. The Superintendent's decisions shall be subject to review by the Board of Education at its next regular meeting.
