B. Representative and Deliberate Groups

(8) Administrative Reports/Annual Reports

The Board shall require reports from the Superintendent of Schools concerning the state of the school system.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for submitting to the Board an annual report, prior to the beginning of the next school year, indicating the effectiveness of the instructional program, the condition of the schools, and plans and suggestions for their improvement as well as other items of interest to the Board members.

The Board shall file an annual financial report with the State in accordance with the law.
